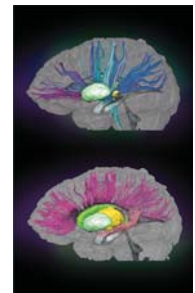

Left lateral views from three-dimensional depictions of fiber pathways published in *MRI Atlas of Human White Matter* by S. Mori, S. Wakana, L.M. Nagae-Poetscher, and P.C.M. van Zijl (Amsterdam, Elsevier, 2005) are featured on the cover and discussed by the authors in *Images in Neuroscience* (p.1005). The atlas presents illustrations based on high-resolution diffusion tensor imaging (DTI) and 3D tract reconstruction to delineate the complex interrelationships that exist among white matter tracts.
