Three articles in this issue underscore the genetic and environmental contributions of maternal depression to childhood psychiatric disorders. Tully et al. (p. 1148) found psychopathology risk increased in adolescents of depressed mothers regardless of adopted status. Pilowsky et al. (p. 1136) examined the changes in psychiatric symptoms among children of depressed mothers who received treatment in the STAR*D trial, and Swartz et al. (p. 1155) compared the effects of maternal interpersonal psychotherapy with that of treatment as usual on the depression levels in offspring. These articles suggest maternal depression treatment can be a preventive intervention for lowering childhood psychopathology risk.
