



Double-Blind Placebo-Controlled Study of Memantine in Trichotillomania and Skin-Picking Disorder

Trichotillomania and skin-picking disorder are common psychiatric disorders that lack clearly effective treatments. This study examined memantine, a generic medication that may modulate glutamate in the brain, compared to placebo. The findings suggest that memantine may be an effective treatment for reducing both hair-pulling and skin-picking behavior.
