

used by other groups, such as Al-Qaeda, indicating that these strategies are not unique to the Taliban. In addition, the book falls short of explaining how these strategies have been influenced by the presence of Al-Qaeda in Afghanistan and by political entities that fund the Taliban. Notwithstanding these comments, this book makes a valuable contribution to the literature in the field.
